**Political Science- Assistant Professor- Tenure Track Position**

**Political Science, Assistant Professor, Tenure Track**, to teach upper-division courses in the areas of public administration, methodology, political behavior, and judicial process. The position begins in January, 2010. The position also requires one to teach two or three survey courses each semester (these may include: Introduction to Government and Politics, American Government, and State Government and Politics). Faculty teach four courses each semester. The position will also require supervision of internships within state and local government agencies. Candidates with doctorates are preferred, although ABDs who have firm plans to earn their degree by June 1, 2010 will be accepted. Interviews for this position will be conducted at the American Political Science Association to be held in Toronto, Canada from Sept. 3 – Sept 5, for those who attend. The review process will begin September 15 and continue until the position is filled.
