CLASS	PRAXIS REQUIREMENTS <i>Reminder: Candidates are exempt from Praxis One if the ACT composite score is 26.</i>
Education 200	Review Praxis site by visiting ets.org; review sample tests in Reading, Writing and Mathematics and become familiar with the waiver procedures.
Education 201	Must take Praxis One as a class requirement. All three sections of the test must be passed in order to advance to 300 level courses and be admitted to candidacy for teacher education.
Education 202	Must take and pass Praxis One as a requirement for this course. In order to advance to 300-level courses, all three sections must be passed. If difficulty is experienced in passing the Praxis One, enroll in Education 299 courses in Reading, Writing, or Mathematics.
All 300 Level Courses	Be reminded that the Praxis Content test must be passed before a candidate can be admitted to student teaching. Prepare for the PLT and the Praxis Content by focusing on the material in the textbooks and by visiting ets.org for sample tests. Candidates are encouraged to keep your education and content test books to build your personal resources library and to review the content.
Education 426	The Praxis Content test must be passed before a candidate can be admitted to student teaching. This is the education course before student teaching; therefore, passing scores are required.
Teacher-in-Residence (TIR)	Any candidate who wishes to be considered for a TIR position must have successfully completed all coursework with a 3.0 GPA and must have passing scores on Praxis Content and the PLT.
Education 480 (Student Teaching)	Prerequisite: Must have passed the Praxis Content
WV Teaching Certification	Certification requirements: Passing Scores on the PLT
