Position Description

The Department of Mathematics, Engineering, and Computer Science at West Virginia State University invites applications for a full-time Instructor of Computer Science position starting Fall 2023. This position is renewable annually depending on teaching performance and institutional need.

Responsibilities for the Position

Responsibilities include teaching elementary computer science courses and participation in department and university committees. The normal teaching load is 15 credit hours per semester. The ability to teach elementary mathematics classes is a plus.

Requirements for the Position

A Master's degree (or 18 graduate coursework semester hours) in Computer Science or a related field from an accredited college or university is required. The successful candidate is expected to have some teaching experience at secondary or post-secondary levels. The successful candidate will need to complete a background check.

Salary Statement

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Appointment Status

This is a 9-month, full-time, benefit-eligible, instructor position.

Proposed Starting Date

The anticipated start date for this position will be at the beginning of the Fall 2023 semester.

This position will remain open until filled. However, first consideration will be given to applicants who submit a resume, cover letter, unofficial academic transcripts (official transcripts will be required at hiring), and the names (with email addresses and phone numbers) of three professional references by July 21, 2023. All requested information must be submitted for your application to be considered.
